Day 95 : Herringbone Twill Knit Stitch

Material:

I used [Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick & Quick](#), a super bulky yarn, Fisherman [Size 11 {8mm} needles with 24" {60cm} circular cable](#) [Darning needle](#), or tool of choice to weave in ends [Scissors](#)

Pattern:

CO in multiples of 4

Row 1 = Right side/Front

Rows 1 & 5: *K2, YFWD, SL2, YBK*

Rows 2 & 6: S1 *YFWD, P2, YBK, SL2* P3

Rows 3, 7, 9, 13: *YFWD, SL2, YBK, K2*

Rows 4, 8, 12, 16: P1 *YBK, SL2, YFWD, P2* YBK, SL2, YFWD, P1

Rows 10 & 14: S1 *YFWD, P2, YBK, SL2* YFWD, P2, SL1

Rows 11 & 15: *YBK, K2, YFW, SL2*

Repeat rows 1-16, until desired length.

Abbreviations:

* - * - repeat pattern

CO - cast-on

K - knit stitches {example: K1 means to knit 1 stitch}

P - purl stitches {example: P2 means to purl 2 stitches}

YFWD - hold yarn forward, in front of work

SL2 - slip 2 stitches, purlwise

YBK - hold yarn in back of work

SL1 - slip 1 stitch, purlwise
