Day 90 : Honeycomb Knit Stitch





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Material:

I used [Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick & Quick](#), a super bulky yarn, Fisherman
[Size 11 {8mm} needles with 24" {60cm} circular cable](#)
[Darning needle](#), or tool of choice to weave in ends
[Scissors](#)

Pattern:

C0 in multiples of 8

Row 1 = Right side/Front

Row 1: *C4B, C4F*

Row 2, 4, 6, 8: *P*

Row 3 & 7 *K*

Row 5: *C4F, C4B*

Repeat rows 1-8, until desired length.

Abbreviations:

* - * - repeat pattern

C0 - cast-on

K - knit stitches {example: K1 means to knit 1 stitch}

P - purl stitches {example: P2 means to purl 2 stitches}

C4F - cable4front {Transfer 2 stitches to a cable needle and hold it in the front of your work, knit the next 2 stitches and then knit the 2 stitches off the cable needle}

C4B - cable4back {Transfer 2 stitches to a cable needle and hold it in the back of your work, knit the next 2 stitches and then knit the 2 stitches off the cable needle}
