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## Day 99 : Knit Stitch

### Material:

I used [Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick & Quick](#), a super bulky yarn, Fisherman  
[Size 11 {8mm} needles with 24" {60cm} circular cable](#)  
[Darning needle](#), or tool of choice to weave in ends  
[Cable needle](#)  
[Scissors](#)

### Pattern:

C0 in multiples of 8 +2

Row 1 = Right side/Front

Row 1, 3, 5, 7: \*K\*

Row 2, 4, 6, 8: \*K2, P6\* K2

Row 9 & 11: K7 \*S1PW, K2, S1PW, K4\* K3

Row 10 & 12: K7 \*YFWD, S1PW, YBK, K2, YFWD, S1PW, YBK, K4\* K3

Row 13: K7 \*SL3 to DPN and hold in back, K1, SL2 from DPN to LH needle and bring DPN with 1 st to the front of your work, K2 from LH needle, K1 from DPN, K4\* K3

Row 14: \*K2, P6\* K2 {same as row 2}

Repeat rows 1-14, until desired length.

### Abbreviations:

\* - \* - repeat pattern

C0 - cast-on

K - knit stitches {example: K1 means to knit 1 stitch}

P - purl stitches {example: P2 means to purl 2 stitches}

YFWD - with the yarn in front

YBK - with the yarn in back

S1PW - slip 1 purlwise

DPN - Double pointed needle {or cable needle}

SL2 - slip 2 stitches

SL3 - slip 3 stitches

LH - left hand
