Day 9 : Sand Tracks Knit Stitch

Material:

I used [Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick & Quick](#), a super bulky yarn, Fisherman
[Size 11 {8mm} needles with 24" {60cm} circular cable](#)
[Darning needle](#), or tool of choice to weave in ends
[Cable Needle](#)
[Scissors](#)

Pattern:

C0 in multiples of 12
Row 1 = Right side/Front

Row 1: *C6F, K6*

Rows 2,4,6,8: *P*

Rows 3, 7: *K*

Row 5: *K6, C6B*

Repeat rows 1-8, until desired length.

Abbreviations:

* - * - repeat pattern

C0 - cast-on

K - knit stitches {example: K1 means to knit 1 stitch}

P - purl stitches {example: P2 means to purl 2 stitches}

C6F - cable6front {Transfer 3 stitches to a cable needle and hold it in the FRONT of your work, knit the next 3 stitches and then knit the 3 stitches off the cable needle}

C6B - cable6back {Transfer 3 stitches to a cable needle and hold it in the BACK of your work, knit the next 3 stitches and then knit the 3 stitches off the cable needle}
