Day 97 : Small Cross-Stitch Knit Stitch
Knit-in-the-Round





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Material:

I used Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick & Quick, a super bulky yarn, Fisherman
[Size 11 {8mm} needles with 16" {60cm} circular cable](#)
[Darning needle](#), or tool of choice to weave in ends
[Scissors](#)

Pattern:

CO in multiples of 6

Row 1: P2 *K2, P4* K2, P2
Row 2: P2 *K2, P4* K2, P2
Row 3: P1 *CR, CL, P2* CR, CL, P1
Row 4: P1 *K1, P2* K1, P1
Row 5: *CR, P2, CL*
Row 6: K1, P4 *K2, P4* K1
Row 7: K1 *P4, K2* P4, K1
Row 8: K1, P4 *K2, P4* K1 {same as row 6}
Row 9: *CL, P2, CR*
Row 10: P1 *K1, P2* K1, P1 {same as row 4}
Row 11: P1 *CL, CR, P2* CL, CR, P1
Row 12: P2 *K2, P4* K2, P2 {same as row 2}

Repeat rows 1-12, until desired length.

Abbreviations:

* - * - repeat pattern
CO - cast-on
K - knit stitches {example: K1 means to knit 1 stitch}
P - purl stitches {example: P2 means to purl 2 stitches}

CR: Knit into the front of the second stitch, and then the front of the first stitch and then slip both stitches off.

CL: Knit into the back of the second stitch, and then the back of the first stitch and then slip both off.
